The Counseling Department of Central High School would like to make you aware of the PSAT/NMSQT (National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) testing opportunity on **October 11, 2017**. We would like for your son/daughter to have the chance to take the test in October. The PSAT/NMSQT measures the knowledge and skills that research shows are the most essential for college and career readiness and success. Students can only take the PSAT **once a year**. Normally students take the PSAT in both the 10th and 11th grades, only junior year scores will count towards the National Merit Scholarship program.
